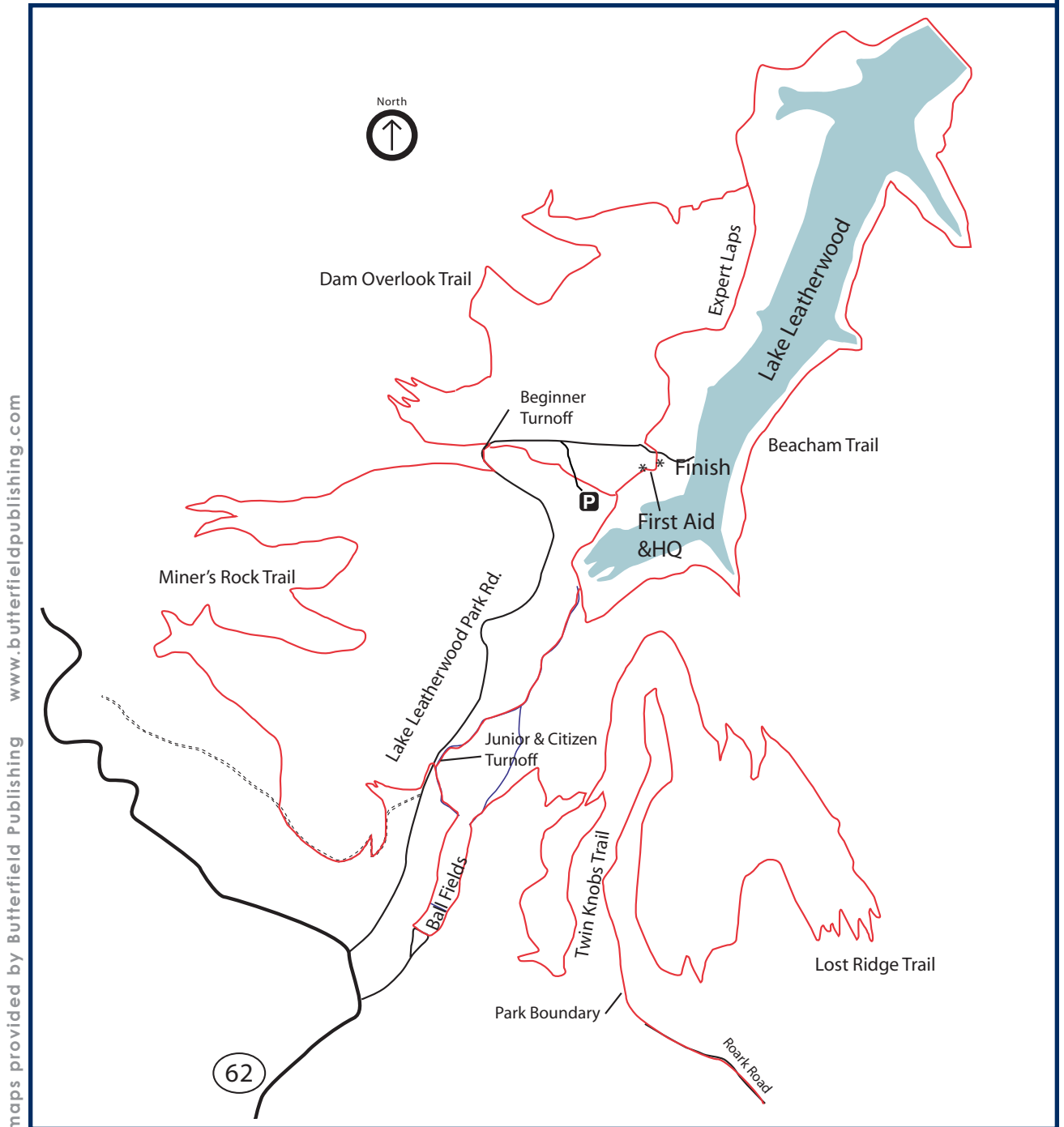

DOWNHILL
